WHAT:

Private piano lessons (25 minutes).

WHEN:

During the school day at your child's school.

WHO:

Students in Grades 1-8.

COST:

Cost per semester for lessons, books, and materials is \$350.00. ***This averages out to less than \$25 per lesson, considering the price includes books, and we come to your child's school to teach!*** There are two semesters per school year; 14 lessons per semester. Full tuition for each semester is due before lessons begin. Payment is made through Walther. If you need to divide payments up, you may talk with your teacher to work out

a payment plan.

REQUIREMENTS:

Student must have a keyboard or piano in their home. Regular practicing at home is necessary for success.

INCLUDED **ACTIVITIES:** Learning proper hand positioning, technique, rhythm recognition. and note reading.

Music theory activities Participation in recital(s).

ATTENDANCE .

Lesson times are worked out between the piano instructor and your student's classroom teacher. Lessons will fall on the same day each week, except in special circumstances. Students are required to be in attendance and bring their materials to their scheduled weekly lesson. As stated above, students receive 14 lessons per semester. Make-up lessons occur at the end of each semester. If students are absent or do not have their materials on their lesson day, we cannot guarantee that lesson be made up. Teacher absences for any reason will be made up at the end of the semester. Piano students will perform a recital at Walther in May and students are expected to attend.

EXITING THE PROGRAM: Students may discontinue lessons at the conclusion of each semester. To exit the program, request an EXIT FORM from your instructor. Clearly state all reasons for discontinuing lessons, and return it to your school. If you decide to leave in the middle of the semester, you

will still be responsible to pay for the entire semester.

ENROLLMENT:

To enroll your child in lessons, just fill out the attached sheet (read it carefully) and return it to

your school office.
