From the Principal's Desk:

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior!

I wanted to tell you about our Tuition Reimbursement
Incentive Program, or TRIP. Many, many families in past years
have banked hundreds of dollars in savings on their tuition
payment.

What is the TRIP program? TRIP/RaiseRight is an organization that sells gift cards to help non-profits earn money. We promote this program to help YOU save money. This is how it works.

When we get our savings percentage from RaiseRight, we return 75% of that money to the participating parents to help reduce their tuition. Trinity school uses 25% for shipping costs and the tuition assistance fund. When you purchase gift cards, you get the whole amount on the card + a percentage back towards tuition.

It is entirely up to you how much you use TRIP. The more you order, the more money you will earn back. It is an easy program to use. RaiseRight online offers credit card, debit card, and checking account payments. You can also pay by check in the office. The RaiseRight mobile app is super easy to use. You can sign in with your RaiseRight username and password and access your gift cards right away for e-cards and reloads. Trinity's direct access code is C73LF95B7L57.

Our next school online order is DUE by 9:00 a.m., Monday, Nov. 6. When you order, you are helping Trinity, as well as, reducing your tuition. And who doesn't like to save a little money? Go to raiseright.com to get started!




