Cook County DOTH Bridge Closure Notification for the Wolf Road Bridge. In October or early November (schedule is not set yet) the Wolf Road Bridge over Flag Creek will be closed. Traffic will be detoured during approximate 3 weeks of construction.

Carotid Artery Disease: An ultrasound is performed to screen the carotid arteries (a pair of blood vessels in the neck that deliver blood to your brain) for buildup of fatty plague. This buildup, called atherosclerosis, is
