AFTER SCHOOL DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

In order to have an orderly and safe dismissal from school, we have enacted the following rules:

- Students will line up in their classrooms or the hallways, but will not be dismissed to the lobby until the bell rings at 3:15 p.m. (or 11:30 a.m. on half days).
- If you must take your child before 3:15 p.m., you must come to the school office and sign him/her out.
- Preschool will be dismissed at 3:00 p.m.
- On away game days, athletes and their siblings may be dismissed before 3:15 p.m.
- Athletes may be dismissed to the locker room or gym for practices or home games.

In order to have a SAFE dismissal time:

*please do not allow your child/children to walk between or behind cars

*please make sure your child/children has/have their seatbelts on

*please drive slowly in the parking lot.

At dismissal time, the teachers are there to make sure that their students go home with the appropriate adult. They should not have to remind adults about proper parking lot etiquette.

There may be other rules enacted as the need arises.



PARKING

- Parking along the curb is prohibited at any time of the day. Drivers may wait along the curb but must remain in the car in case he/she is asked to move. This includes no parking on the corner or along the east side of the school as well as the curb in front of school. If you are near a curb, you must remain in your car.
- Neither parking nor waiting is allowed in the striped area immediately in front of the school entrance. This area is for crossing or loading only.
- If you are waiting along the curb, a teacher, directing traffic, may ask you to move.
- Students should enter and leave their vehicles on the curb side only.
- At no time can we allow traffic to back up onto German Church Road. Please move to the lot or drive around if you are blocking the entrance.
- If you must park, park in the lot between two yellow lines.
- Vehicles parked in the lot next to the gym must park facing German Church Road.
- Cars are ONLY allowed to drive forward when exiting a parking spot.
- Cars are NOT to reverse out of a parking spot.

- Make sure children are secure with a seat belt and/or in car seats before driving off.
- Please observe a 5 mph speed limit.
- If you come in to the school to pick up your children, please walk with them to your car. We do not want students walking through the parking lot unsupervised.
- **REMINDER:** *In Illinois, it is against the law to be using a cell phone in a school zone. This includes in our parking lot. People have been ticketed.*
